# Coronavirus: Information about mRNA vaccinations in the canton of Bern



**Vaccination is voluntary and free of charge. You will need 2 mRNA vaccinations that are given 4-6 weeks apart.**



**What do I need to do to get vaccinated?**

Anyone aged 5 and over can register and book an appointment at <https://be.vacme.ch>.



**Am I eligible to receive the vaccination?**

Yes, if you:

- > are 5 years or older
- > do not have a fever and exhibit no other COVID-19 symptoms
- > have no allergies to any component of the vaccine
- > are not in isolation or quarantine
- > are in week 12 or later of pregnancy

Allergy sufferers with severe reactions to vaccines and people with severe immune suppression must consult their doctor before being vaccinated.



**How do walk-in vaccinations work?**

Simply register at <https://be.vacme.ch> without booking an appointment and then go to a walk-in vaccination centre during its opening hours.

If you don't have internet access, please go a vaccination centre that offers walk-in vaccinations. You will receive assistance there with your registration.

**What do I have to consider if I am between 12 and 15 years old?**

Youths capable of exercising judgement do not need to be accompanied to the vaccination appointment by a person with parental authority.

# Coronavirus: Information about Janssen (Johnson&Johnson) vaccinations in the canton of Bern



**Vaccination is voluntary and free of charge. You will only need 1 vaccination with the Janssen COVID-19 vaccine.**



**Am I eligible to receive the Janssen COVID-19 vaccination?**

Yes, if you:

- > are 18 years or older
- > do not have a fever and exhibit no other COVID-19 symptoms
- > have no allergies to any component of the vaccine
- > are not in isolation or quarantine

Allergy sufferers with severe reactions to vaccines and people with severe immune suppression must consult their doctor before being vaccinated.



**Who should not get vaccinated with the Janssen COVID-19 vaccine?**

- > People who are particularly vulnerable
- > Pregnant and breastfeeding women




**What do I need to do to get vaccinated?**

**Validity of the vaccination certificate**

After receiving a Janssen COVID-19 vaccination, your vaccination certificate will only become valid 22 days after your vaccination.
